

ENMC Young Scientists Program

Purpose of the program is to enable young researchers, clinicians and health care providers to participate in an ENMC workshop related to their field of expertise, with the aim of giving them the opportunity to obtain state-of-the-art scientific information and networking opportunities, promoting the concept of the ENMC and making the field (more) attractive for young professionals.

Eligibility criteria

- researcher/clinician/health care provider involved in neuromuscular disorders
- finalized PhD not longer than 5 years ago

Application procedure

- Provide a CV and a 1 page document with the following information:
 - why is the topic of this workshop of relevance for your research a/o practice ?
 - how will your participation in this workshop contribute to your professional career?
 - have you collaborated with one of the organisers about your role at the workshop?
- Applications should be sent to the ENMC office at least 3 months prior to the workshop date.
- The ENMC Research Director, in consultation with the workshop organiser and the Managing Director, will decide on the applications to be selected.
- Applicants will be informed by the ENMC office on their application 2 months prior to the workshop date.
- For each ENMC workshop, a maximum of two participants from the Young Scientists Program may attend.

Rules & Conditions

- The Young Scientist Program selected candidates will sign a confidentiality statement at start of meeting, hence it is not allowed to disseminate any information that was shared during the workshop, except for public domain information.
- The maximum reimbursement for travel expenses in this program is € 300 for European participants and € 1.000 for participants from other continents.
- Accommodation at the workshop venue is included in the Young Scientist Grant (registration, hotel, meal, local transport to workshop venue).
- Participants will receive a certificate of attendance for the workshop.

- After signing off the GDPR approval document, they will be included in the ENMC mailing list and LinkedIn group.
- Participants will be asked to collaborate with the organiser(s) on the preparation of the workshop, have a presentation and/or may help in writing the lay and/or full report (publication) of the workshop attended.
- Young scientists are encouraged to apply on their own initiative but may also be recommended by an organiser, a participating research group or institute.
